	Camp-1 Year Segment	The number represents the years of attendance at Summer Camp (e.g.; 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, etc.).
	Cub Scout Day Camp Segment	Volunteer for at least 2 days at a Cub Scout Day Camp event.
	Fall Camporee Segment	Attending a Council or District Fall Camporee.
	Fireman's Chit	Earn the Fireman's Chit.
	ILST Segment (old JLT)	Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST) - formerly Junior Leadership Training (JLT).
	Keep America Beautiful Segment	Participate in picking up trash for a service event (e.g.; 42nd Street Clean Up).
	Parade Segment	Participate in a Parade while in your Class A uniform.

	Popcorn Segment	Sell popcorn in the Council's popcorn sales.
	Quinzhee/Igloo Segment	Winter camping in a quinzee, snow fort, or igloo.
	Recruiter Segment	Recruit a new member to the Scouts BSA.
	Religious Segment	Earn the Scouts BSA Religious Award for your faith.
	Scouting for Food Segment	Scouting for Food - participate in delivering bags, picking up food, or sorting food.
